

The Sunshine Golf Club Junior Program is designed to support the junior golfer through a pathway of improvement and development.

Junior Pathway (ages 12-17)

Step 1: The Junior golfer is introduced to golf at the club through the professional coaching clinics

Step 2: The Junior becomes a Junior member of the club (see membership categories and fees)

Step 3: The Junior participates in the Junior development coaching program (further details to be provided)

Step 4: When reaching the appropriate level, the Junior development officer promotes the Junior into 9 hole Sunday competition play

Step 5: The Junior then progresses to 18 competition play under the direction of the junior development officer

Step 6: The Junior becomes a Sunshine Golf Club pennant representative, state golf representative and then a possible professional career in golf.

Sub Junior Pathway (Ages 8-11)

Step 1: The sub-junior is introduced to golf through the professional coaching (conducted on the golf range) or social supervised play by parent or guardian.

Step 2: The sub-junior becomes a sub-junior member of the club (see membership categories, playing rights and fees). He / she may play on the course after 3.30pm and must be supervised by a parent or guardian at all times within the club.

Step 3: The sub-junior participates in the clubs Junior development coaching program

Step 4: When the sub-junior reaches 12 years of age or when the junior development officer officially approves, the sub-junior may then participate in the Sunday 9- hole competition play.
